Cliff Saunders received his BSc in Electrical Engineering at the University of Aston in Birmingham, England. He worked as a Systems Engineer at British Aircraft Corporation (BAC) for several years before returning to Aston for his MSc in Applied Psychology. Upon returning to BAC as an Ergonomist, Cliff worked on a variety of weapons systems. During this period, he was awarded a number of patents on products he developed for BAC.

In 1977, Cliff moved to Ottawa, Canada to work in the emerging field of Human-Machine Interface with the Department of Human Factors at Bell Northern Research (now Nortel Networks).

Subsequently, he was seconded by Bell Canada to manage part of the Saudi Telephone Company's training operation in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. During his five years in Saudi, Cliff researched the impact of this training on the local Saudi population. This formed the basis of his doctoral work in Cybernetics.

When he returned to Canada, he continued his work with Nortel in the areas of product design, training and marketing. It was during this time that he made contact with, and was influenced by Professors Michael Porter of Harvard University and Robert Cooper of McMaster University.

For the next three years, Cliff headed the Nortel Innovation Centre. The Centre encouraged the company's inventors to have their personal ideas and inventions evaluated in a safe environment. Cliff was instrumental in bringing a number of these inventions successfully into the marketplace to the benefit of both the inventor and the company.

Throughout this period, Cliff observed, with increasing concern, that impediments to success in the corporate environment often lay in group processes. For groups to be effective in solving complicated problems, they need to be provided with new tools and processes. In searching for solutions, he discovered the work of Professor John Warfield.

Warfield's work in Interpretive Structural Modeling (ISM) provided the theoretical underpinnings for Cliff's development of The Resolver System, a user friendly management expert system which combines behavioral techniques with world class software for a group decision-making process that has proven to be among the best and most robust on the market.

In conjunction with this powerful tool, Cliff has evolved a number of behavioral methods for facilitating group interaction, based on his own expertise and that of other key specialists in the field of group decision support.

He is now a Partner at Too Serious! "Limited, a Facilitation, Speaking and Social Engineering Games Company in the U.S. and Canada. He also co-owns and manages barrettSaunders & Associates, a group decision support software company with clients worldwide.
